Guidelines for Applicants**

**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND CONTACT US IF YOU HAVE FURTHER QUESTIONS**

**Who can apply:**

Any CAMHS professional. We do not accept applications from parents. You must be based in the UK and be employed by the NHS or Local Authority. If you are employed by any other organisation eg a charity please contact Evelyn for advice before applying.

**What will we fund:**

We want to support the work you do with children and families by funding items that are not eligible for NHS funding. We are aware that funding levels differ between regions. We have drawn up a list of items that we have provided in the past to give some idea of the types of items we can fund. The list is not exhaustive and there is space to add other items. If you are not sure about whether to apply for a certain item, please give us a call.

**How much can you apply for?**

The upper limit for each application is £1,000. If more than one member of your team is applying, please ensure the combined total is under £1,000. If you have a very small caseload (under 100 at any time) we will fund up to £500 of equipment.

**The application process:**

All application forms must be received by **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2018**. No late applications will be accepted. We will then review the applications and let you know the outcome within one week of the deadline. Your resources will be distributed once the project funding had been completed which could be up to six months later.

**Exclusions**

- We can't pay salaries
- We will not fund anything that can be obtained on prescription
- We will not fund items for adults.
