CHARITY OVERVIEW

MedEquip4Kids improves the health of children and babies in the UK by providing equipment not available from limited NHS resources. We believe every child should have access to the best medical care when they need it most.

MedEquip4Kids was set up in 1985 by a couple after their daughter became seriously ill with meningitis and was treated at Booth Hall Children's Hospital in Manchester, where she made a full recovery. At the time, the hospital was unable to afford some vital items of equipment, so to show their gratitude to the hospital that saved their daughter's life, the couple began fundraising for the equipment.

Since then MedEquip4Kids has raised over £20 million. Last year our work benefited over 117,500 children a year at hospitals across the North West of England and beyond. The equipment we provide includes:

- ✓ Upgraded or additional items of medical equipment for children's wards, including neo natal monitors, incubators, defibrillators and other items that can help improve the care offered to the most vulnerable children.
- ✓ Play facilities and improved environments that help to calm and distract children from their illness, giving them and their families a better experience of hospital treatment. These include multisensory rooms, soft play areas, sensory gardens, and child-friendly artwork to brighten up a clinical-looking hospital ward.
- ✓ Specialised equipment to help children with serious illnesses and disabilities to enjoy a better quality of life. This includes mobility equipment such as walking frames and crutches.
- ✓ Training tools to help disabled children to overcome problems with continence.
- ✓ Resources including books, toys and games to improve children's mental health.

JOB OVERVIEW

6. Initiate hospital fundraising, engaging and supporting hospital staff.
7. Build long-lasting relationships within the local community delivering talks and presentations to encourage ongoing support.
8. Develop relationships with local media, including press, radio and digital.
9. Take accountability for online marketing and social media updates across various platforms.
10. Manage own administration, ensuring accurate and up to date financial reporting.
11. Deliver against a specific income target, reporting to the CEO providing regular fundraising updates.
12. To support the wider fundraising team and undertake other duties appropriate to the role, as required
13. Represent MedEquip4Kids in a positive and professional manner at all times, maintaining the ethos of the organization.
